

Defense Information System for Security (DISS) Gateway

In the fall of 2006, the Defense Information System for Security (DISS) Gateway will allow single sign-on. This means that once you enter the DISS Gateway, all applications the user is authorized to use, e.g., JPAS, DCII, etc. will be available without the user having to enter another userid and password. This is important because the JPAS Gateway will no longer be the primary entry point for access to these applications.

When the DISS Gateway allows single sign-on DSS will no longer allow the JPAS Gateway to be the primary point for entry. This DSS website will only be available as a backup system to the DISS Gateway. Over time, the pertinent information on the JPAS Gateway will be moved to the DISS Gateway.

I want to emphasize once more for those who book marked the JPAS Gateway, please bookmark the DISS Gateway. DSS will ensure we are provided sufficient time to notify our agency before removing the JPAS login button on the JPAS Gateway. In addition, at the appropriate time, DSS will also place a popup directing users to the new DISS Gateway.
