#### **Federal Statistics**

- The Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) is the federal agency responsible for administering Medicaid and EPSDT.
- The Maternal and Child Health Bureau (MCHB) maintains a web-based data and information site, which contains data on child health activities and outcomes in the states and territories.
