COMMAND SERGEANT MAJOR SA'EED A. MUSTAFA

Command Sgt. Maj. Sa'eed A. Mustafa assumed responsibility in the U.S. Army Garrison Wiesbaden July 10, 2012.

Command Sgt. Maj. Mustafa is a native of Highland Falls, N.Y. He enlisted in the Army in May 1984, attended basic training at Fort Bliss, Texas, and advanced individual training at Fort Belvoir, Va., where he graduated as a 91D, power generation repairman.



Command Sgt. Maj. Mustafa's first duty assignment was as a generator mechanic in the 109th Forward Support Battalion, 9th Infantry Division, Fort Lewis, Wash. He reenlisted and went to Fort Lee, Va., to the Petroleum and Water Course where he was awarded the military occupational specialty of 92F, petroleum supply specialist. His subsequent assignments include: Pump Station foreman in the 20th Quartermaster Company (Pipeline); Weagwan, Korea; Petroleum Section sergeant, HHC 4-64th Armor, Fort Stewart, Ga.; Section sergeant and Battalion Reenlistment NCO in Company A, Headquarters and Headquarters Company 296th FSB, 2nd Infantry Division, Camp Edwards, Korea; Petroleum Platoon sergeant in 226th S&S, 87th CSB, Fort Stewart, Ga.; POL/Ammo Platoon Sergeant, D Company, 4th-123rd Aviation BN, Fort Wainwright, Alaska; HQ PSG, Operations Sergeant, and First Sergeant in the 59th Quartermaster Petroleum Supply Company, 52nd Engineer Bn & 68th CSB, Fort Carson, Colo.; first sergeant, Headquarters Support Company U, 602nd Aviation Support Battalion, 2nd Infantry Division, Camp Stanley, Korea; Company (No Slack), 262nd Quartermaster Battalion, Fort Lee, Va.; HHC, 262nd Quartermaster Battalion; Fort Lee, Va; A Company, U.S. Army Sergeants Major Academy, Class 57. After completion of the U.S. Army Sergeants Major Course, he was assigned as Operations Sergeant for the 189th Corps Support Battalion and Operations Sergeant Major of the 7th Transportation Battalion, 507th Corps Support Group, Fort Bragg, NC.

Command Sgt. Maj. Mustafa has deployed in leadership positions in Operations Desert Storm, Restore Hope, Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation New Dawn. He successfully deployed the 121st Brigade Support Battalion as part of the 4th Brigade Combat Team as the Army's first Advise and Assist Brigade in 2009 to 2010. Command Sgt. Maj. Mustafa last served as the command sergeant major of the 123rd Brigade Support Battalion, 4th BCT, 1st Armored Division, Fort Bliss, Texas, where he recently returned in December from a deployment to Iraq as a member of Operation New Dawn and one of the last of the American Soldiers out of Iraq.

Command Sgt. Maj. Mustafa's military education includes WLC, ALC, SLC, First Sergeants Course, Battle Staff Course, EO Course, and U.S. Army Sergeants Major Course-Class 57. He holds a Bachelor of Science in Human Services, and is nearing the completion of attaining a master's degree in human resource development.

Command Sgt. Maj. Mustafa's awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal with one oak leaf cluster, Meritorious Service Medal with two leaf clusters, Army Commendation Medal with five leaf clusters; Army Achievement Medal with two oak leaf clusters; Army Good Conduct Medal (eighth award). His badges include the Combat Action Badge, and both the driver and mechanic Badge.
