



RE: Political Matters

- 1) Scheduling If Mitchell gets into the subject of surrogate candidates, you might want to say that the current system is less than satisfactory with the President, and that as a result you have asked Dwight Chapin, Gordon Strachan, Ron Walker and others here to work with Magruder and Porter to develop a new, more effective system.
- 2) Intelligence Gordon Liddy's intelligence operation proposal (\$300) has been approved. Now you may want to cover with Mitchell who will be privy to the information.

  The current system is Magruder and Reisner. (Magruder's Administrative Assistant). Now that Liddy will begin receiving this political intelligence information, you may want to cover with Mitchell, who should be charged with the responsibility of translating the intelligence into an appropriate pelitical response. If it is to be Colson, you may want to lay the groundwork with Mitchell now. Mitchell may suggest Buchana, who enjoys that role.

- 3) Polling When will Bob Teeter's campaign strategy memoranda Dogin arriving? As I understand it, he spent his vacation last week reviewing a list of priority memoranda that you had discussed with him. Generally, are we getting enough analysis from Teeter's part time efforts for the campaign.
- 4) Teddy White Who will be interviewing Teddy White
  ("aking of the President) at 1701? In light of his connections
  with Numberey, should it be just Van Shueway? Or Magruder?
- 5) FNC Convention Are there any reasons for leaving San Diago?

  As you know the President will not stay at the Sheraton or have a room there.

- 7) California Chotiner, Finch and Miller are increasingly critical of Mofziger and organization in California. Mofziger is unhappy with Magruder and the "lack of direction from National." Are you going to meet personally with Mofziger next Monday?
- 8) Harry Fleaming YYou currently have a talking paper for Witchell to remove Fleaming per the President's request. In light of this you may want to cover with witchell Fleaming's new

assignment to run seven meetings with the regional political leaders at the end of April.

When will Bob Mardian begin assuming a political role?

- 9) Herb Kalmbach On April 7, he will no longer be associate chairman under Stans, but will return to his "special assignment" status. Will you be able to make much use of him?
- 10) New York Magruder mentioned that 1991 will begin working directly with Rockefeller's group. Is there anything we should be doing to assist this new relationship?

Kalmbach called to say that David Rockefeller, who had been quite concerned about not seeing the President to discuss the international economic situation, delivered his 50 today. Again, is there any follow-up necessary in our part?

- 11) Fred Malek He mseems to have moved into the campaign role we discussed for him. Have there been any problems that I could help resolve?
- 12) PNC Apparently, Tom Evans is continuing to block Jack Buttram as Mofziger's replacement in the communications area.

Evans says he needs to see you. Colson, Malek and Magruder agree Buttram is the man. Should Magruder or Malek direct Evans on your behalf to hire Buttram?

Evans sent Ed DeBolt's March report on the RNC Target '72 registration drive, and frankly, it is quite depressing.

Is this a priority project or should we just let the RNC go its way?

- 13) Pennsylvania Magruder has been advised that the President is interested in getting our Surrogates into Penns lvania to counter the Democrat's attacks. Would you give some direction to Jeb regarding which Surrogates we want in which areas?
- 14) Campaign Strategy Should you, Connally, Finch, Ehrlichman, Dent, Colson and I sit down to review our current position and develop some recommendations for the President?
