

Major Changes in the 120917 Version of the TCCC Curriculum from the Previous Curriculum of 110808

Added a recommendation for the use of ketamine for battlefield analgesia.

Added the 4th or 5th ICS at the MAL as an alternative site for needle decompression of tension pneumothorax.

Added guidance for the management of moderate/severe Traumatic Brain Injury.

Changed mention of specific airway devices to more generic “supraglottic airway” in Tactical Evacuation Care.
