Classification Categories

All disabilities

Basketball

This tournament will consist of four, ten player (maximum) teams. The four teams will represent the Army, Navy, Air Force and Marines.

Cycling

Events and Classification Categories

Handcycle Men - 10 kilometers

Disability: Lower mobility impairment/amputation that prohibits one from riding a two wheel upright bike

Recumbent Cycle Men - 20 kilometers

Disability: Upper mobility, orthopedic and/or balance issues that prohibits one from riding a two wheel upright bike or handcycle

Handcycle/Recumbent Cycle/Bicycle Women - 10 Kilometers

Open Disability: Permanent physical disability and PTSD, TBI, Orthopedic

Bicycle Men Open - 30 kilometers

Open Disability: No physical permanent disability (PTSD, TBI, Orthopedic)

Bicycle Men Physical Disability - 30 kilometers

Disability: Permanent physical disability (ie: amputation)

Tandem Men\Women\Mixed Visually Impaired - 30 kilometers

Disability: Visually impaired (visual acuity of 20/200 or greater, best corrected, in both eyes and/or a visual field of less than 20 degrees)

10m Air Pistol	Open and SH1
10m Air Rifle Standing	Open, SH2, and SH1
10m Air Rifle Prone	Open, SH2 and SH1

Classification Categories

Open Category – Includes competitors who do not have a permanent physical disability (PTSD, TBI, orthopedic)

SH2 Category – Includes competitors who do not have the ability to support the weight of the firearm with their arms and therefore require a shooting stand (upper body injuries, arm amputees, etc.)

SH1 Category – Includes all other competitors with permanent physical disability (spinal cord injury, leg amputees, stroke, etc.)

Classification Categories

Single leg amputees

Double leg amputees

Below the elbow permanent impairment/amputation

Open – Blind/visually impaired, PTSD, TBI, orthopedic injuries (visual acuity of 20/200, best corrected, in both eyes and/or a visual field of less than 20 degrees)

Classification Categories

Single below the knee amputees and double below the knee amputees

Upper body amputees, limb dysfunction and visually impaired (visual acuity of 20/200 or greater, best corrected, in both eyes and/or a visual field of less than 20 degrees)

Wheelchair racing athletes

Open - No physical permanent disability (PTSD, TBI, orthopedic injuries)
