NEW RAO DIRECTOR - FEBRUARY 2012

We would like to welcome Paul R. Groskreutz, Colonel, USAF (Ret.) as the new Director of the Retiree Affairs Offices here in Minneapolis. We would also like to thank Ralph T. Carlson, Colonel, USAF (Ret.) for his selfless service to the RAO as Director. Ralph will be staying on as a volunteer. Here are a few highlights of Col Groskreutz's distinguished career. He is no stranger to Minneapolis and the 934th AW.

Paul Groskreutz retired from U.S. Federal Civil Service and the U.S. Air Force in March 2007 after completing 40 years. His last duty assignment was as the Commander, 622nd Regional Support Group, Dobbins ARB, GA, where he was the senior mission support officer.

Paul began his career when he enlisted in the Air Force in 1967. He served on active duty for over seven years as a Historian and in public affairs. The duty stations included Ellsworth AFB, SD; Tan Son Nhut AB, RVN and Grand Forks AFB, ND.

Upon leaving the AF, Paul returned to Minnesota to work for the Veterans Administration at the St Paul Regional Office and Insurance Center.

Shortly after he began working for the VA, he rejoined the Air Force as a member of the Air Force Reserve. In 1979 he received a direct commission, a goal he had pursued since obtaining his bachelor's degree in 1972. Assigned to the 934 Airlift Wing, he performed duties as a reserve officer in Education, Personnel, Public Affairs and Security.

In 1993 Paul joined his civilian and military careers by becoming an Air Reserve Technician with the 934th. He initially was the Deputy Mission Support Group Commander. Upon being promoted to Lieutenant Colonel he became the Group Commander and served as such until his transfer to Dobbins in 2003. He served there as the 622nd Regional Support Group Commander and senior mission support officer in 22nd Air Force. He retired with the rank of Colonel in March 2007.

That summer he was elected to serve as the National President for the Reserve Officers Association of the United States (ROA). He is currently the US Vice President for Interallied Confederation of Reserve Officers, commonly referred to as CIOR.

You should do this every time you move, even temporarily (pay attention "snow birds"). Dependents and spouses should check the expiration date on their ID cards to make sure they are kept current. Medical benefits depend upon a current identification card and current address information in DEERS. The quickest way to update your address, phone number, or e-mail address is through the DEERS Web site at www.dmdc.osd.mil, then select "DOD Community", then select "Personnel Services". You may call (800) 538-9552 between 0900 and 1800 Eastern Time, Wednesday through Friday. You should do this every time you move, even temporarily (pay attention "snow birds").

PERMANENT ID CARDS FOR 75+ SPOUSES:

- ♦ Spouses of military retirees that are 75 years old can now get permanent dependent ID cards (If your current card is within 90 days of expiring) This can be done by mail through the 934th AW Customer Service. Call that office for instructions on mail procedures at (612) 713-1085. (Takes about 30 days to process)
- ♦ Another option Sponsor can bring a 3 X 4 or larger Recent Photo of their dependent spouse if spouse cannot physically come with.

FINANCE OFFICE ASSISTANCE:

The 934th AW Finance Office can help you with some adjustments to your retired pay account. The office is located in building 852 on the first floor, phone (612) 713-1407/1411. Their help is particularly handy for those that do not have computer access to the DFAS myPay web site. They can reset your myPay pin number, assist with filling out forms for electronic funds transfers, and they offer free faxing of military pay related information.

TRICARE Goes Digital:

♦ TRICARE for Life (TFL) beneficiaries will soon be able to print a copy of their Explanation of Benefits (EOB) from the convenience of their own homes. Starting this month, the only paper EOB's that TFL beneficiaries living in the United States and U.S. territories will receive will be monthly summaries. In

February, beneficiaries will have the option to receive an electronic notification every time a claim processes by logging on to the secure website at www.TRICARE4U.com to view and print their EOB. For more information about the registration process, beneficiaries can call toll-free at 1-866-773-0404 or at the Telecommunications Device for the Deaf (TDD) telephone number 1-866-773-0405.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS INSTRUCTIONS:

If you need to have your address changed you must send the changes to the appropriate agency as indicated below:

- ◆ <u>Retirees:</u>Notify <u>Defense Finance and Accounting Service</u>, <u>US Military Retirement Pay</u>, <u>PO Box 7130</u>, <u>London</u>, <u>KY 40742-7130</u>. Mark the envelope "change of address" and be sure to include your retired grade, Social Security number, and signature. Phone (800) 321-1080, FAX (800) 469-6559.
- ◆ Annuitants (Surviving spouses receiving SBP or RSFPP payments): Notify **Defense Finance** and Accounting Service, US Military Annuitant Pay, PO Box 7131, London, KY 40742-7131. Include retired grade and Social Security number of your sponsor, your Social Security number, and signature. This is the only agency that can change addresses of annuitants. Phone (800) 321-1080, FAX (800) 982-8459.
- ♦ <u>Gray Area Retirees (under 60 reserve & guard qualified</u>): Call Air Reserve Personnel Center (ARPC) in Denver (800) 525-0102 to change your address.
