

**Interim Report of the  
OPTN/UNOS Transplant Coordinators Committee  
Live Meeting  
June 11, 2012**

**I. Old Business**

Inactive Waitlist Management. Research staff then presented data on the most recent length of inactivity for inactive registrations removed from the waiting list during 2007-2011 for reasons of death or too sick. Highlights from this data include:

- 20,543 registrations were removed from the waiting list for death and 12,270 registrations were removed from the waiting list because the candidate was too sick
- 22.5% of inactive KIDNEY registrations were removed for death after being inactive for 1 to less than 2 years.
- There were a total of 1,111 inactive registrations removed from the waiting list during 2007-2011 for death or too sick that had been inactively waiting for 5 years or more prior to removal.
- There were a total of 95 inactive registrations removed from the waiting list during 2007-2011 for death or too sick that had been inactively waiting for 10 years or more prior to removal.

As such, members agreed that a patient notification policy is warranted and will plan to make this a multi-committee effort.

**II. New Business**

Policy Proposals Issued for Public Comment. Members were presented with the proposed policy modification on improved imaging criteria for HCC exceptions. Although a quorum was not met, members voted in support [For 4: Against 1: Abstentions 0]

UNet waitlist application. Members reviewed screen shots in UNet’s waitlist application. The committee agreed that a column needed to be added to indicate days inactive (greatest to least) for their patients. This would enable the coordinator to stay informed of how long their patient has been inactive.
