

Workflow 9: Formatting the Mass Haul Diagram Sheet

1. Select the "Mass Haul" worksheet tab. The base worksheet file already contains data ranges that need to be revised. Click inside the chart window to highlight the chart, right click, and select Source Data. Select the "Data Range" tab, the data range references the "Station" and "Mass Ordinate" columns of the "XSData" worksheet. The following formula will be shown in the Data Range data field:

=XSDATA!\$A\$9:\$A\$<u>83</u>,XSDATA!\$AL\$9:\$AL\$<u>83</u>

Change the end row number to match the last row in the "XSData" worksheet. Select 'OK'.




Fig. 12-24: Mass Haul Diagram data range selection.

2. The mass haul diagram will update to the newly defined data set. The diagram may have to be adjusted to achieve a satisfactory print. To modify any of the elements in the diagram, click on the item, right click and select the "format" choice. Each item contains several adjustments.
