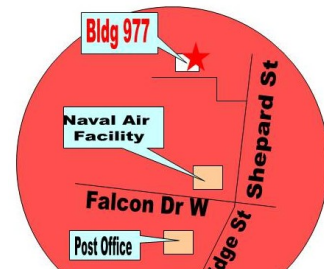

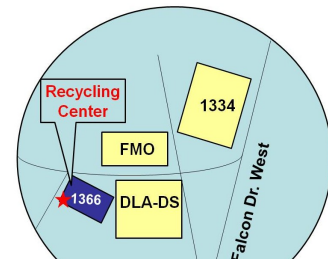
Fluorescent bulbs: from MFH must be turned in to Self-Help, bring old bulb to exchange for a new one. Bldg 794, 226-4992

Pet Waste Management

Pet Waste Stations: Provided throughout Misawa AB neighborhoods

- **Home for dog waste:** Recommend flushing dog waste *without* the bag, or it should be double-bagged and set out as burnable trash at least once a week.
- **Cat waste:** Pet owners should dispose of double-bagged cat feces with their burnable garbage at least once a week. Cat waste can contain the Toxoplasma parasite, which can harm humans who come into contact with the cat waste.
