












Separation and Disposal of Garbage and Recyclables

All trash should be put out your designated pick up area by 8 a.m. on it's authorized collection day!
Not following the procedures below is **ILLEGAL DUMPING**, Violators will be reported to first sergeant

Recyclable Ensure items are in separate bags!	Paper	<p>Newspaper and Office/copy paper</p>  <p>Magazine, Catalog</p>  <p>Flatten Milk Carton</p> 	<p>Unclean paper (such as pizza boxes and hamburger wrappings), foil, paper package with aluminum coating inside, carbon paper, iron-on transfer paper, paper containers for yogurt/ice cream, paper containers for detergent and shredded paper</p> <p>Please put them out as Burnable Garbage</p>
	Cardboard	   <p>Please flatten, bind with string or put in plastic bag</p>	<p>Unclean cardboard box (such as pizza box and any oil soaked), please put them out as burnable garbage</p>
	Cans	   <p>Food and beverages steel, tin and aluminum cans</p> <p>Please empty and rinse</p>	<p>Metal items less than 50 pounds or 6 feet in length (Pots, kettles, empty paint can, cutlery, metal spoon, metal fork, umbrella ribs, wire hangers and other)</p>
	PET/PETE	   <p>#1 PET/PETE only</p> <p>Please empty, rinse and take cap off</p>	<p>Plastic PET/PETE bottles with recycling logo of beverage bottle, water bottle only</p>
	Glass bottle/jar Ceramics	  <p>Beverage and food glass bottles/jar, cup, glass, cosmetic bottles, bottles for chemicals, ceramic plat, ceramic cup</p> <p>Please empty, rinse and take cap off</p>

Make sure charcoal and ash are cooled down prior to disposal.

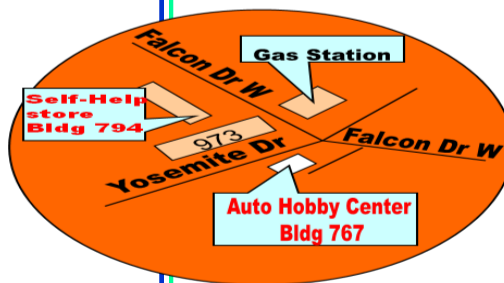

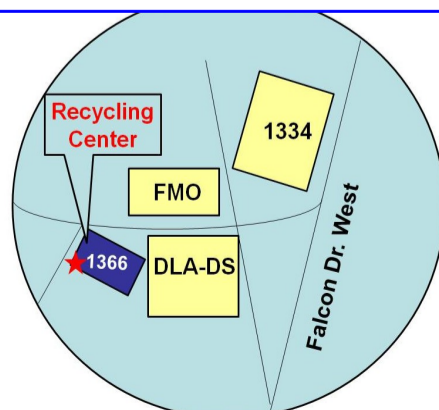
