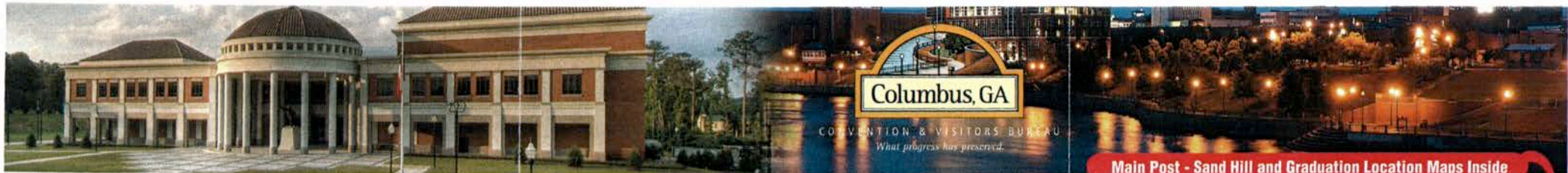

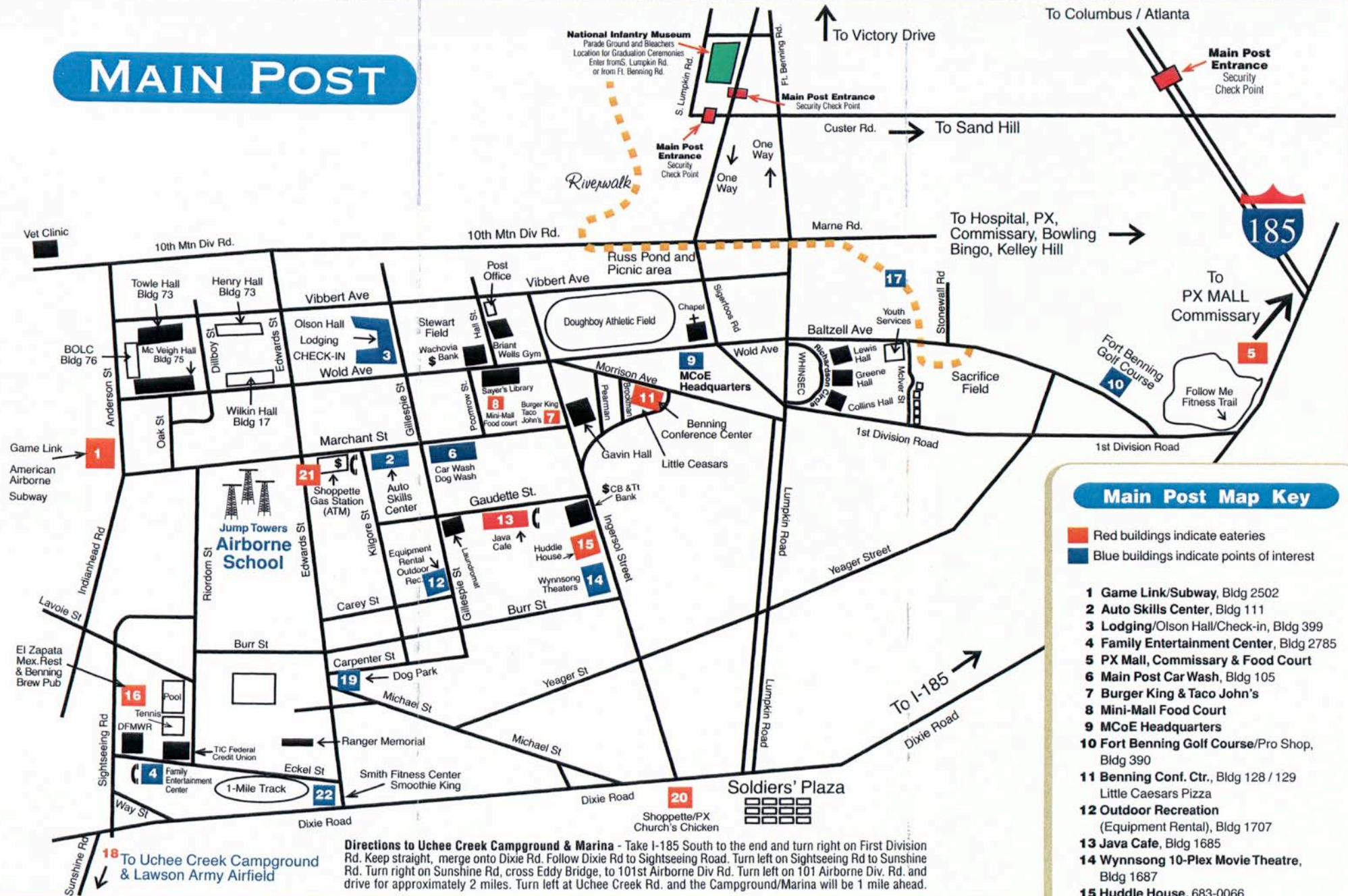


Main Post - Sand Hill and Graduation Location Maps Inside

## MAIN POST



**Directions to Uchee Creek Campground & Marina** - Take I-185 South to the end and turn right on First Division Rd. Keep straight, merge onto Dixie Rd. Follow Dixie Rd to Sightseeing Road. Turn left on Sightseeing Rd to Sunshine Rd. Turn right on Sunshine Rd, cross Eddy Bridge, to 101st Airborne Div. Rd. Turn left on 101 Airborne Div. Rd. and drive for approximately 2 miles. Turn left at Uchee Creek Rd. and the Campground/Marina will be 1 mile ahead.

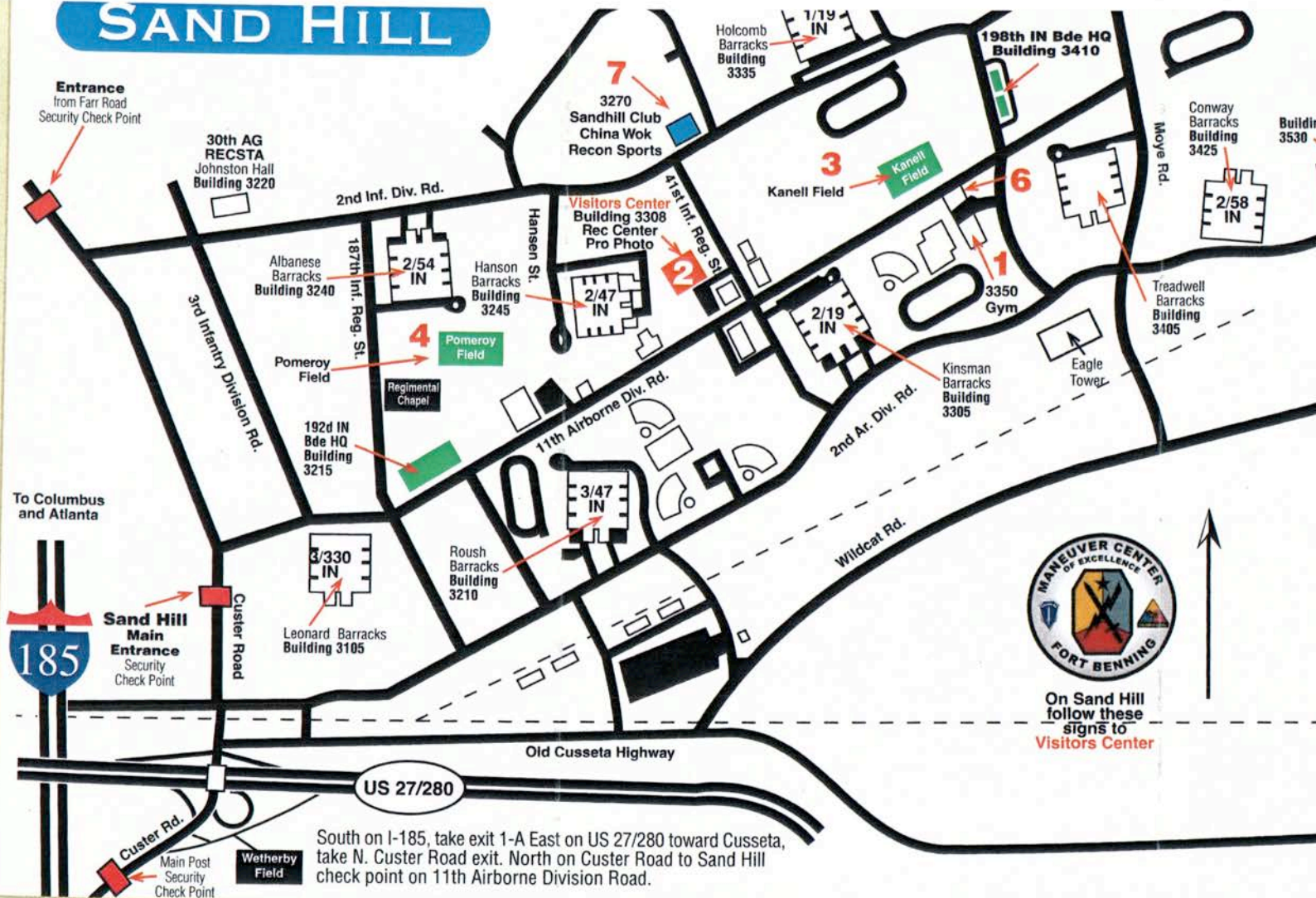
