American Recovery and Reinvestment Act:

Funding will support laboratory research, design, testing, and fabrication of a prototype Metacapacitor, an electrical power capacitor capable of converting energy in a switched-capacitor fashion, while operating as a high power density, low loss technology platform for load management and power conversion. The proposed work is consistent with the goal of ADEPT: fundamental advances in soft magnetics, high voltage switches, and reliable, high-density charge storage.

Proposed work consists entirely of RD&D work to be completed in laboratory, manufacturing and testing facilities located at City University of New York's Energy Institute (New York, NY); Columbia University (New York, NY); University of California, Berkeley (Berkeley, CA); Kodak R&D laboratory (Rochester, NY); and Techni-Met, LLC. The work performed will be limited to on-site research, design, development, testing, and evaluation.
