The chaplain corps is the only base agency that guarantees you 100% complete confidentiality. Everything mentioned to a chaplain as a matter of conscience is confidential.

People ask if this includes thoughts of suicide, homicide or crimes. Yes! **There are no exceptions.** Chaplains have no duty to warn. Your secret is safe.



Field Counseling: Chaplains often conduct informal counseling in the field. Informal counseling is also 100% confidential.

AFI 52-101, 4.1.1.1

Obligation to confidentiality.

The "Code of Ethics for Chaplains of the Armed Services" affirms that all chaplains will hold in confidence any privileged communication received during the conduct of his/her ministry. The manual for Courts-Martial further affirms the absolute character of such privileged communication within the context of judicial proceedings and investigations.

WORKPLACE

-WORK-

Visitation: Unit visitation is an important part of chapel support. Chaplains & chaplain assistants visit work areas in order to minister to Airmen & gauge/raise morale.

Advice to Leadership: Chaplains and chaplain assistants advise leadership on ethics, moral and morale matters that affect their troops. They provide Airmen a confidential and direct channel to voice concerns to commanders.

Workplace Counseling:

Chaplains provide counseling regarding a host of work-related matters ranging from disciplinary issues to job dissatisfaction. Counseling is available at your workplace or at the chapel.

Sexual Assault Prevention & Response:

Chaplains are available 24/7 to victims of sexual assault for restricted reporting & post-trauma counseling.

Religious Accommodation: We work with leadership to grant you religious accommodations. Such requests should be granted pursuant to DoDI 1300.17.

Marriage & Relationship Counseling: Maintaining marriages & relationships are of paramount concern to the Air Force. Chaplains can provide you with skills to improve marital, family & non-family relationships.

Marriage Retreats: Take advantage of weekend retreats where “Family-Life”-trained chaplains equip couples with spiritually-based & theoretically-sound principles to enhance your marriage.

Weddings: Airmen are welcome to book one of our two spacious chapels for wedding ceremonies.

Premarital Counseling: Many religious groups require couples to obtain premarital counseling. We encourage all couples to learn the skills that will forever enhance their future marriage.

Families of the Deployed Events: The chapel, along with other base helping agencies, host quarterly events for families of the deployed. Enjoy a meal, children's activities & meet other families facing the challenges of deployment.

Deployed Support: The **55th Wing** has one of the highest deployment rates in the Air Force. The chapel is here for your family while you're gone. Please let your family know that we are here to help.

Suicide Intervention: Suicide deaths have surpassed combat deaths, but suicide is preventable. Chaplains are available 24/7 to speak with you or your wingman thinking about suicide. This counseling is 100% confidential & will not affect your career at all. The chapel staff is also available to teach suicide intervention skills to an entire unit or squadron.
