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MIDDLE EAST DISTRICT AWARDS \$3.8B in MATOC CONTRACTS

WINCHESTER, Va. -- The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Middle East District announced today that it has awarded, on behalf of the Transatlantic Division and the Army Corps of Engineers, Multiple Award Task Order Contracts (MATOCs) to 14 firms.

These MATOCs support design-build and construction projects throughout the 20 countries of U.S. Central Command's area of responsibility which is defined as including Afghanistan, Bahrain, Egypt, Iran, Iraq, Jordan, Kazakhstan, Kuwait, Kyrgyzstan, Lebanon, Oman, Pakistan, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Syria, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, U.A.E., Uzbekistan and Yemen.

The awardees, listed below, are guaranteed a minimum \$10,000 and the right to compete for individual task orders for up to \$3.8 billion in work. The period of performance is a base of two calendar years from award, and up to three one-year option years.

The contract was competed using a full and open, unrestricted process in accordance with the Federal Acquisition Regulation. This process provides a fair and impartial evaluation of the proposals received from all proposers, and the final selection was based upon the Government's evaluation of all criteria established for this MATOC.
