Laura Green Zeilinger is the Deputy Director of the United States Interagency Council on Homelessness. In this role, she collaborates with the 19 federal agencies on the Council regarding national homelessness policy and coordinates national engagement through the work of USICH's Regional Coordinators serving across the country. Laura first joined USICH in 2011 as the Director of National Engagement and Field Support, where she was responsible for overseeing the strategic implementation of *Opening Doors: Federal Strategic Plan to Prevent and End Homelessness* in states and major metropolitan areas. Prior to joining USICH, Laura spent four years working for the government of the District of Columbia, in the Executive Office of the Mayor and in the Department of Human Services, overseeing the implementation of programs for the District's most vulnerable residents, including those experiencing homelessness. She is an attorney with a longstanding commitment to underserved populations.
