Parents with concerns about their school-age child's academic, social, or emotional progress should contact their child's teacher. Special education and regular education teachers work together to assist students experiencing difficulties in school by planning and implementing strategies for success in the regular classroom.

Special educational services are also available to preschoolers. Preschool children ages three and four with developmental delays, physical disabilities, significant learning problems, or speech/language disorders may be eligible for special education services. If you are concerned about your preschooler, you may call the Special Education Office at 545-5520 for information regarding the preschool program. Services are available for infants and toddlers, ages 0-2 through Early Intervention Services at 545-3835/9116.
