UNDP activities with the Anti-Corruption Agency

As of August 2010, UNDP works with the Anti-Corruption Agency through several projects for which the agency is either a main partner or indirect beneficiary.

UNDP is providing direct support for a larger-scale project. To date, UNDP has supported the Agency in promoting its mandate throughout Serbia (e.g. explaining to local level officials how they should declare assets, etc.), several trainings for the staff, including coaching by a former Hong Kong senior official of their ICAC and other smaller scale events (e.g., Anti-Corruption day).
