

## **Kevin F. Boyne**

Kevin F. Boyne has been a criminal investigator with the Department of Defense (DoD) Office of Inspector General, Defense Criminal Investigative Service (DCIS) since 1989. He has served DCIS in the San Diego, Wiesbaden, Germany, San Francisco, and Saint Louis offices in a variety of agent and supervisory positions. DCIS agents conduct investigations involving complex white-collar crime, such as public corruption, product substitution, counter-terrorism, illegal transfers of DoD technology, cyber crimes, and virtually any other illegal activity involving the DoD that is of interest to the Inspector General, the Secretary of Defense or the U.S. Congress.

From 1982 through 1986, Mr. Boyne worked in public accounting and in private industry. In January 1987, Mr. Boyne began his DoD career at the Defense Contract Audit Agency. Mr. Boyne was an adjunct faculty in the San Diego Community College District teaching Financial Accounting and Managerial Accounting from 1987 to 1997. While living in St Louis, he also served as a Police Commissioner in Town and Country, MO. In 2005, Mr. Boyne returned to San Diego to supervise the joint investigation of U.S. Representative Randall "Duke" Cunningham and his conspirators.

Mr. Boyne graduated in 1982 from San Diego State University's School of Business with a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration and Accounting; he also attended the SDSU Graduate School of Accountancy, focusing on Taxation and Production & Operations Management. In 2005, Mr. Boyne received a Masters in Public Administration from Georgetown University. He is a member of the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants and a Certified Fraud Examiner. The U.S. District Court, Southern District of California, recognized Mr. Boyne as an expert witness on Department of Defense (DoD) accounting and international money laundering matters.

Mr. Boyne teaches and speaks about procurement fraud and public corruption investigations at the Inspector General Criminal Investigator Academy, the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center, and San Diego area universities.
