COLONEL DOUGLAS S. CHAMPAGNE

Colonel Douglas S. Champagne is commander of the 127th Operations Group, 127th Wing, Selfridge Air National Guard Base, Michigan. Comprised of the 107th Fighter Squadron and the 127th Operations Support Flight, the 127th Operations Group supports its primary missions of close air support, combat search and rescue and precision attack in the A-10C Thunderbolt II aircraft. The 127th Operations Group provides support to the 127th Wing and the Joint Selfridge Community through trained personnel in the functional areas of airfield management, air traffic control, intelligence, and weather.

Col. Champagne is a graduate of Western Michigan University with a B.S. in Engineering and Applied Science, Aviation. He began his Air Force career in September 1987 receiving his commission from Officer Training School. Champagne earned his wings through Euro-NATO Joint Jet Pilot Training (ENJJPT) at Sheppard AFB, TX, in January 1989.



Following initial pilot training, Col. Champagne served on active duty through June of 1996. Col. Champagne separated from active duty in June 1996 at which time he transitioned from being attached to the 107th Fighter Squadron through the Total Force Project to being a full-time member of the Michigan Air National Guard.

Col. Champagne is a command pilot with over 3,900 flying hours, 3000+ in the F-16, 500+ in the A-10C and over 500 hours of combat time. In 1991, Champagne served in Desert Shield, Desert Storm and Desert Calm where he flew 37 combat missions. On September 11, 2001, Col. Champagne flew in the first fully armed combat air patrol over Detroit. Col. Champagne is a combat experienced fighter pilot and recently served as the 107th Expeditionary Fighter Squadron Commander at Kandahar Airfield, Afghanistan as part of the 451st Expeditionary Operations Group.
