FROM THE AIR TRAFFIC MANAGER

A new year has begun and we will be seeing a lot of changes at Addison Airport and Tower over the next months. The Taxiway Alpha Reconstruction Project will continue for many more months, with a new south holding bay scheduled to open by the end of this month. That will be a huge improvement for the airport, providing a useful area at the south end of the airport for staging of departures and doing equipment checks without impacting other operations. The tower personnel are very much looking forward to having this area available.

There will also be a change in the management of the tower. One of our two Front Line Managers left us in October for a similar position at a higher level facility in Baton Rouge, LA. Our other FLM has been selected for a promotion to a Front Line Manager position at Dallas Love Field. We are looking forward to getting their replacements here in the not too distant future.

This will also be the last Newsletter that you will be receiving from me. I have accepted a position in the private sector (non-aviation related) and will be retiring from the FAA at the end of February. This position will be a totally new and exciting experience/challenge for me, and I am very happy to be making the change.

I would like to publicly express my appreciation to the Addison Airport management team for all of the assistance and leadership they have demonstrated during my time here. Working with Lisa Pyles, Joel Jenkinson, Joe McAnally, and Darci Neuzil has been a true pleasure. TAXIWAY ALPHA RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

The Taxiway Alpha Reconstruction Project is moving along very well, and pretty much on schedule. The current phase of construction, the rebuilding of the south end of Taxiway Alpha and the new construction of a south holding bay, is still scheduled to be completed by the end of February. Until then, we will continue with the same closures and Notices to Airmen that we are currently operating with.

I have not yet been provided with any plans or details of the next phase of the project, or exactly when it will begin. The Airport Management should be announcing that in two to three weeks. We'll get you the information as soon as we know it.

LOCAL RUNWAY SAFETY ACTION TEAM MEETING

The Addison Airport management and Addison Tower will be holding the required annual Local Runway Safety Action Team (LRSAT) Meeting on Wednesday, February 6, 2013 at the Addison Airport Management Offices located at 16051 Addison Road, Suite 220, Addison, TX 75001. All tenants and users of the airport are welcomed to attend and participate in helping us find ways to mitigate the risk of runway incursions and surface incidents. The results of the meeting will help determine the "action plan" that will be utilized for the next year in these efforts.

ADDISON AIR TRAFFIC COUNTS

January 2013 traffic was a bit slower than January a year ago. Weather was not as good, and the weekend partial runway closure also slowed the traffic a bit. It was not a big slow down, and the first few days of February have been very busy for us. We are hoping that trend continues all month.

January Total traffic was down 4.7% from the same month in 2012

January IFR traffic was up 2.0% from the same month in 2012.

January VFR traffic was down 8.8% from the same month in 2012.

January Itinerant count was down 1.8% from the same month in 2012.

January Local operations were <u>up</u> 17.0% from the same month in 2012.

January Over-flight count was up 5.6% from the same month in 2012.
