
MEMORANDUM FOR: SUPPLY PRC MEMBERS

SUBJECT: Approved DLMS Change 48C, Addendum for Revision to DLMS Supplement (DS) 945A, Material Release Advice (Supply)

This addendum provides a revision to the DoD 4000.25-M, Defense Logistics Management System (DLMS), modifying the DS 945A, Material Release Advice. This change is to be incorporated with Approved DLMS Changes 48/48A/48B during implementation. This change is required to support continued logistics operation in a DLMS/DLSS environment.

The DLMS Supplement will be posted to the DLMSO web site (<http://www.dla.mil/j-6/dlms/ICs/Default.htm>) immediately upon coordination/approval of the governing Federal implementation conventions (ICs) from the DoD Logistics Functional Working Group (LFWG), the DoD Electronic Data Interchange Standards Management Committee (EDISMC), and the Federal EDI Standards Management Coordinating Committee (FESMCC). Additionally, the revised DS will be provided for implementation planning on the above web site pending Federal approval.

4. REQUESTED CHANGE:

a. Title: Addendum for Revision to DS 945A, Material Release Advice

b. Description of Change: This change modifies the DLMS Supplement (DS) 945A Material Release Advice to add an additional code to support DLMS/DLSS conversion.

c. Procedures: Revise DS for 945 A, Material Release Advice as follows.

d. Alternatives: None identified.

5. REASON FOR CHANGE: This change supports DLMS implementation and desired functionality. The missing code was identified during testing of conversion processing. This data element was streamlined by intent during development of the DLMS. Under the DLSS, the material release denial perpetuates the required delivery date (RDD) from the original release order. Under full DLMS, it would be unnecessary to return this date to the ICP where it would already be available. However, in order to support conversion to valid DLSS transaction, this data element must be reinstated in the DLMS.

6. ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES:

a. Advantages: Supports DLMS implementation.

b. Disadvantages: None identified.

7. IMPACT:

a. Publications. Federal Implementation Conventions 945A and corresponding DoD 4000.25-M DLMS Supplement. The DS revision requires prior change to the Federal Implementation Convention (IC).

b. DAAS DLMS/DLSS conversion map has been modified to incorporate above revision.
