

SUBJECT: Approved DLMS Change 76, Air Force Unique Coding for Not Mission Capable Supply/Mission Impaired Capability Awaiting Parts (NMCS/MICAP) (Supply) (Staffed by PDC 76)

This change to the DoD 4000.25-M, Defense Logistics Management System (DLMS), is approved for implementation. This change is required to support continued operations in a mixed DLSS/DLMS environment. The approved change DLMS supplements will be posted to the DLMSO web site (<http://www.dla.mil/j-6/dlms/ICs/Default.htm>) within 30 days from the above date for implementation planning. The attached change to DLMS will be incorporated into the DLMS manual/supplements/maps, based upon the effective or availability date to be determined.

# Air Force Unique Management Coding for NMCS/MICAP

### 1. ORIGINATOR:

a. **Service/Agency:** U.S. Air Force, HQ AFMC/LGIA, Wright-Patterson AFB OH 45433-5006

b. **Originator:** Mrs. Bobbie Ziolk

### 2. FUNCTIONAL AREA: Supply

### 3. REQUESTED CHANGE:

a. **Title:** Air Force Unique Management Coding for NMCS/MICAP

b. **Description of Change:** The Air Force will require the use of a new data element to support legacy system requirements to adequately process supply transactions using EC/EDI processes. This data element will be used within our supply system to provide information/justification related to a NMCS/MICAP that is currently identified in the Required Delivery Date field (rp 62-64). When RDD coding identifies a NMCS condition (rp 62=N), a unique AF NMCS/MICAP justification code is reflected in rp 63-64. The two data elements work together. The N in rp 62 is already programmed in Special Requirements Code, but the new AF unique data element is requested for the DLMS in order to perpetuate the data in rp 63-64 required by our legacy systems. A separate 1270 qualifier is being requested so that the AF will continue to maintain control over this unique code list. Other Services/Agencies using DLMS should take no action concerning this code, merely perpetuate it for AF continued use. Per SPRC 02-2 recommendation, DLMSO has included in this proposal a comparable description of the NMCS/MICAP justification coding for publication in MILSTRIP.

### c. Procedures:

(1) **DoD.** Modify MILSTRIP Appendix AP2.14, Priority Designators, Standard and Required Delivery Dates (Record Positions 60-61 and 62-64) to add new subparagraph:

*AP2.14.12.1. USAF requisitioning activities may submit justification for identification of a NIMCS or Mission Impaired Capability Awaiting Parts (MICAP) situation in accordance with USAF guidance. Unique USAF justification coding will be contained in rp 63-64 when rp 62 is N. Other Components will perpetuate justification data with no action.*

(2) **Air Force.** The MICAP information (within the RDD field when rp 62 is N) is currently defined in the Air Force Manual (AFMAN) 23-110, Volume I, Part 4, Chapter 1, and Volume II, Part 2, Chapter 11 (refer to <http://afpubs.hq.af.mil/pubfiles/af/23/afman23-110/PUBS/AF/23/23011002/020211/020211.pdf>).

4. **REASON FOR CHANGE:** This data is a unique data element for Air Force requisition processing that will continue to be used until a standard DoD weapon system coding methodology has been established to which the Air Force will have successfully reprogrammed.

5. **ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES:**

a. **Advantages:** The advantages are to Air Force legacy system requirements based upon the current operating software program logic. The transition from the current legacy management data to a standard weapons system coding structure will be a massive cataloging effort for the Air Force. This requested change provides a logical interim step towards a planned transition to a standard weapon system coding structure and will ensure an uninterrupted flow of the requisition processing capability with Air Force legacy systems.

b. **Disadvantages:** None known.

7. **Segment(s): LQ**

8. **Data Elements:** *Versions 4010 and 4030 (as identified in paragraph 6, above), DE 1270 Code List Qualifier Codes.* Request addition of a separate AF unique qualifier under LQ Industry Code, DE 1270, and the associated code value implementation note to ICs/DSs referenced under paragraph 6, above. Until the new ANSI code is assigned, use an interim substitute code as indicated below:

**RC Requirement Code**

**Federal Note:** Use to identify the Air Force Urgency Justification Code indicating the urgency of need and type of requirement (justification) related to a Not Mission Capable Supply/Mission Impaired Capability Awaiting Parts (NMCS/MICAP) condition.

**DLMS Note:** Use in conjunction with Special Requirements Code N (2/LQ01/Code AL or perpetuated from DLSS Required Delivery Date field). This is an Air Force-unique data element, meaningful to the Air Force only. Non-Air Force Components perpetuate without action. An ANSI data maintenance request has been prepared to request a new data element 1270 code qualifier assignment for the Urgency Justification Code. The code source is identified as the Air Force Manual (AFMAN) 23-110, Volumes 1 and 2.

In addition, include the following clarifying DLMS note 3 in applicable DSs (2/LQ01/Code AL):

**AL Special Requirements Code**

**Federal Note:** Use to identify precedence, special handling, and processing requirements.

**DLMS Note :**

1. Under DLSS this is carried in the Required Delivery Date field.
2. DLMS enhancement, see introductory DLMS note \_\_\_.
3. *Use in conjunction with 2/LQ01/Code RC, Requirement Code, to complete the Air Force unique NMCS/MICAP data requirement.*
