

**3. REQUIRED CHANGE:** This change revises DLMS 527D, as revised by ADC 410 (reference 2.a.), to add the Disposal Turn-in Document (DTID) number as a secondary reference number for PMRs associated with relocation.

**4. BACKGROUND:** The 527D Pre-Positioned Materiel Receipt (PMR) (Relocation)<sup>1</sup> transaction is used when property is to be relocated from one DLA Disposition Services Field Office to another under Reutilization Business Integration (RBI). DLA Disposition Services, using DLA's Enterprise Business System (EBS), creates a 527D PMR transaction to notify the receiving DLA Disposition Services Field Office (which uses Distribution Standard System (DSS)), of the incoming property. ADC 410 addressed revisions to the 527D PMR to support the DLA Disposition Services containerization process under RBI. ADC 410 added the Disposition Services Container ID data element to the PMR transaction for use with Relocation of Material between DLA Disposition Services Field Offices.

**5. REASON FOR CHANGE:** Subsequent to publication of ADC 410, DLA identified the requirement for EBS to include the Disposal Turn-in Document (DTID) number in the 527D PMR (Relocation), so that EBS can pass the DTID number to the Disposition Services Field Office for property being relocated from one field office to another. Providing the DTID number to the field office is necessary so that DSS can provide the appropriate data back to EBS on the DLMS 527R Receipt transaction when property is relocated. When property arrives at the receiving field office in this scenario, DSS must pass EBS the DTID number (as a secondary reference) as it was identified at the supplying field office on the Receipt transaction, in order for DTID number accountability to be maintained across multiple locations. Providing the DTID number to DSS on the PMR, gives DSS that capability to provide the "original DTID number" on the Receipt transaction as outlined in PDC 434 (reference 2.b.). This change supports DLA Disposition Services under RBI.

Applicable only to non-procurement source transactions. This is MILSTRAP Document Identifier (DI) Code DWK functionality.
