

INTEGRATED COASTAL AND OCEAN OBSERVING SYSTEM (ICOOS) ACT OF 2009 IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

ACTIVITY: "implement a merit-based competitive funding process to support non-Federal assets, including the development and maintenance of a network of regional information coordination entities..."

PLAN:

• Objectives/Milestones:

- 1. Conduct FY11 competition in conjunction with National Oceanographic Partnership Program (NOPP)
- **2.** Establish 5-year cooperative agreements with 11 Regional Associations, which will coordinate regional governance and observing system activities.
- **3.** Identify 1 partner with which to establish a 5-year cooperative agreement for national-scale sensor validation and verification activities
- **4.** Document business processes and institute a formal "lessons learned" collection and adjudication process
- Execution Plan: The U.S. IOOS® Program will partner with NOPP to coordinate the FY11 funding opportunity for the purpose of developing and maintaining a network of regional information and coordination entities
 - When publishing a funding opportunity aligned with IOOS strategic objectives, the federal program officer (s) will follow the "Guidelines for the Preparation of Public Notices Announcing the Availability of Financial Assistance – Synopses, Federal Funding Opportunity (FFO) Announcements, and Federal Register Notices" as outlined in Chapter 19 of the Department of Commerce Grants Manual.
 - When conducting a merit-based competitive funding process, the federal program officer(s) will follow the "Merit Review, Selection, Approval, and Notification Procedures" as outlined in Chapter 8 of the Department of Commerce Grants Manual.
 - o In a new competition year, once awards are issued, IOOS staff involved in administering the grants process will document lessons learned throughout the

process. For any major issues identified, a corrective action plan will be written in order to course correct before the next FFO.
