



## Community Facilities Investments 2009-2011

- Invested in over 6,250 critical community facilities,
- Serving nearly 29 million rural residents,
- Including 736 education facilities, 433 libraries,
   581 health care facilities, and 2,800 public safety facilities.



\$1.6 million renovation and expansion of Eastover Branch Library in Eastover, South Carolina. Rural Development funds will help the library include a computer and homework lab, add computers for public use, provide a meeting room for community use, increase staff and operating hours to make the library more accessible to the community.



## Renewable Energy Investments 2009-2011



RD energy programs have supported the growth of the wood pellet industry in SC.

- Helped lead an effort to promote domestic production of renewable energy with potential to create hundreds of thousands of rural jobs.
- Invested in research, supported farmers growing bioenergy feedstocks, and helped support more than 230 bioenergy projects, including construction of 5 biorefineries.
- Helped 25,000 rural small businesses, farmers, and ranchers save energy and improve their bottom line by installing renewable energy systems and energy efficiency solutions.

# **Energy Efficiency**

Energy efficiency projects are broken into three major categories:


- Buildings examples: heating/air conditioning (HVAC); lighting; windows
- Industrial examples: energy efficient equipment; grain dryers
- Other propane systems such as conversion in poultry houses; reverse osmosis for maple sugar producers


