The March meeting of the D. C. Intelligence Chapter of the Reserve Officers Association will be held on Tuesday evening, 11 March 1947, at 8 PM at the Officers Club, 1800 New Hampshire Avenue, N.W. (one block south of Dupont Circle). The speaker of the evening will be Major General G. S. Chamberlin, Director of Intelligence, War Department General Staff, and Chief of the Military Intelligence Reserve. He will talk on present and future intelligence activities of the War Department. General Chamberlin has been a staunch supporter of the Chapter since its beginning last fall. He has commended it for its initiative and enterprise and is in sympathy with its stated objectives, one of them being the promotion of military officers in this area. General Chamberlin's talk will be of special interest to all members of the Chapter, particularly to officers of the MIA Reserve.

A copy of the resolution on national intelligence which was unanimously adopted at the Chapter's meeting on 18 February 1947 is attached for your information. It has been forwarded to the Executive Director of the RMA, who will present it in the near future to an RMA recommendation to the Joint Fact-Finding Committee of the Senate and House of Representatives. It may be of interest to you to know that many individuals with wide experience in the field of intelligence, for instance Major General W. J. Donovan, have heartily endorsed this resolution.

The annual assembly of the D. C. Chapter of the RMA is tentatively scheduled for 27 April 1947. General W. J. Donovan, the Chapter's Delegate to the D. C. Chapter, will be in charge of all details concerning the same. His participation in this assembly.
