58 SOW MISSION





Train mission-ready special operations, personnel recovery, missile site support, and UH-1 DV airlift aircrews in direct support of Air **Expeditionary Forces for the** world's best aerospace force











THE 58 SOW IS







 1800+ personnel in two groups (3500 with family members)



- 3 operating locations
- 1900 students per year
- Training for 29 aircrew positions
- 16-hour daily flying window
 - 15% of ABQ Sunport activity















C-130 Replacement Effort



- Average age of current fleet is 38 years old*
- New C-130J will replace current fleet
- "J model" more capable and more quiet than current inventory
- Replacement effort to be phased over time



C-130 Replacement



- Comment period on draft environmental assessment (EA) concluded 10 November
 - Comments will be evaluated/addressed in final EA
 - Draft EA was based on a potential 13 aircraft; however, final program may likely fund less than 9 aircraft
- Noise contours used were most recent contours provided by City of Albuquerque Aviation Department under FAA Part 129
 - City is expected to publish updated contours on or about 3
 Jan 2011
 - Noise Section of EA will be updated with new contours and we will have another 30-day comment period



Flying Operations



- Airmen must train the way they fight; training tasks and conditions must be as realistic as the conditions Airmen will experience in combat
- Night flying has been an essential part of our rigorous training for decades with little or no variation
- Strict adherence to FAA and AF flight rules is mandatory for our training
- Snapshot of normal operations
