## NOTICE

Kirtland Air Force Base (KAFB) has completed a discretionary Five-Year Review to evaluate implementation and performance of selected remedies for restoration sites in the Environmental Restoration Program (ERP), Environmental Compliance Program (ECP), and the Military Munitions Response Program (MMRP); and to determine if the selected remedy is or will be protective of human health and the environment. Five-Year Reviews are conducted to meet statutory mandate under Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) §121(c) and as a matter of Air Force and EPA policy.

Currently, there are a total of 255 restoration sites for ERP and ECP and 32 MMRP sites on KAFB. Each site was evaluated to determine protectiveness, issues, recommendations, and follow-up actions directly related to protectiveness of the remedy. As part of the Five-Year review process, a site inspection was conducted and interviews with the site manager and site personnel were conducted. The Five-Year Review Report has been submitted to EPA Region 6 for review and comment.
