Who are we? Patient Liaisons assigned to the 31st Medical Group's TOPA Flight are responsible for providing urgent and routine translator/interpreter services and medical administrative assistance to eligible DoD beneficiaries in need of medical care. Services are rendered at various host nation hospitals and specialty clinics in the local area.

What services do the Patient Liaisons provide?

- Interpreter services and triage assistance at Pordenone Hospital Emergency Room
- Interpreter services during outpatient consultations and diagnostic procedures at Pordenone Hospital and outlying host nation medical facilities
- Administrative and interpreter services during hospitalization in off-base hospitals
- Written translations for host nation medical care, discharge, emergency reports, and inpatient medical records
- Appointment booking for referred care in the host nation sector

What do I do in case of an emergency?

An '**emergency**' is defined as a life-threatening situation resulting in possible loss of life, limb, or eyesight.

In the case of an emergency, report immediately to the nearest local Emergency Room. To dispatch a translator, call Command Post at DSN 632-3100.

For non-emergent medical care questions or concerns, call the **Nurse Advice Line** at **DSN 632-5000** or the **Italian Toll Free Number at 800-87-7660.**

What is the Physician Liaison Program?

- A Team of Host Nation Providers, screened and selected by the 31 MDG, to provide visitation and coordination of care services to patients admitted in downtown facilities
- An adjunct service to the Patient Liaison program
- 24/7 medical liaison assistance

All about the On-Call Interpreter Program

- A unique team of interpreters providing daily coverage during shift hours from 1700 to 0700 Monday through Friday and 24 hours per day on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays
- Provide translator support for eligible DoD beneficiaries on behalf of the 31 MDG
- 24/7 interpretation at Pordenone Hospital Emergency Room for minor to life threatening injuries
- Assist patients based on priority depending on the patient's medical condition and care requirements
- Report to Pordenone Hospital
 Emergency Room approximately
 30 minutes after notification



Off-base medical appointments

- specialty appointment not available at the MTF, you may proceed directly to the RMC, where you will be provided your off-base options and a complete briefing on the process. Additionally, you will provide your availability and verify your contact information
- Your referral will be faxed to International SOS (ISOS), our TRICARE partner in health care, for an authorization
- Once TRICARE receives the authorization from ISOS, the referral is deferred to the Patient Liaison Team for appointment scheduling
- Liaison Services will contact you with the off base appointment, details, and instructions.
- Under the terms of the ISOS contract, please be advised that all beneficiaries are subject to be billed by the contractor for missed appointments

Exit the Gate and head towards Pordenone. Drive past Roveredo for 4 and 1/2 miles until you reach a T-intersection where you turn right (the Paradiso restaurant is on your right). Drive 1 mile to the next traffic light. The Palazzetti Fire Place shop is on your left. Proceed straight for 800 ft to the next traffic light – this is the main entrance to the Hospital. The Emergency Room is on your left. Report to TRIAGE immediately where the interpreter will meet you.
