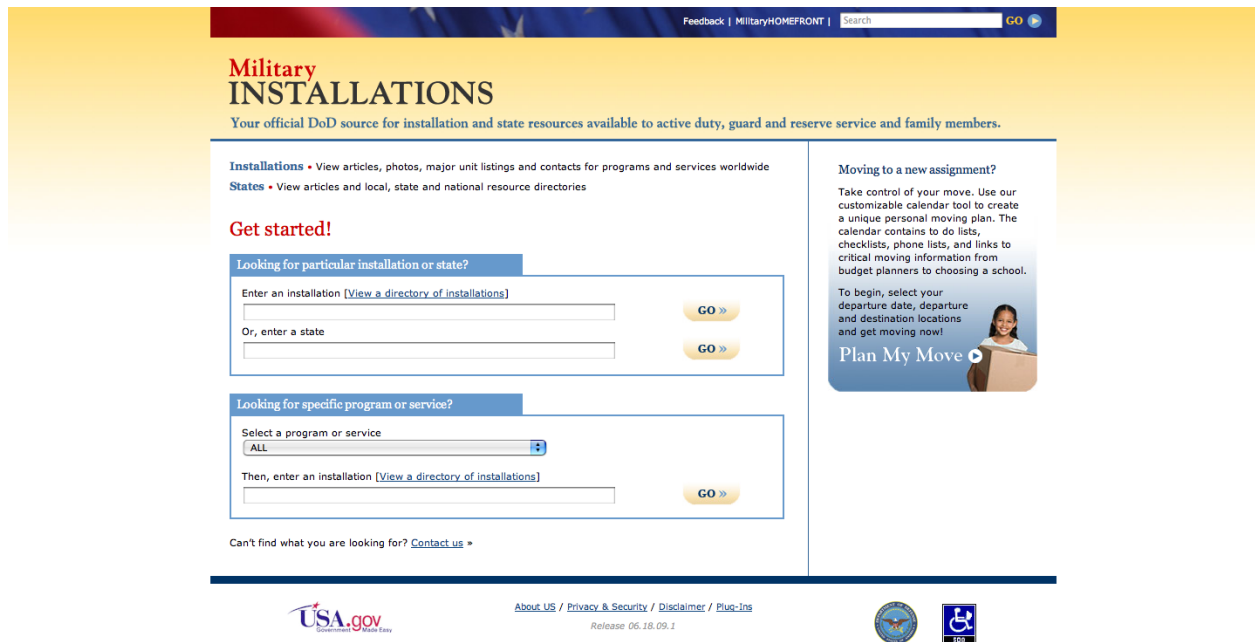

Please take a minute to page through this user guide. We will point out some of the key ways that *MilitaryINSTALLATIONS* can help you quickly locate information about your state and installation.



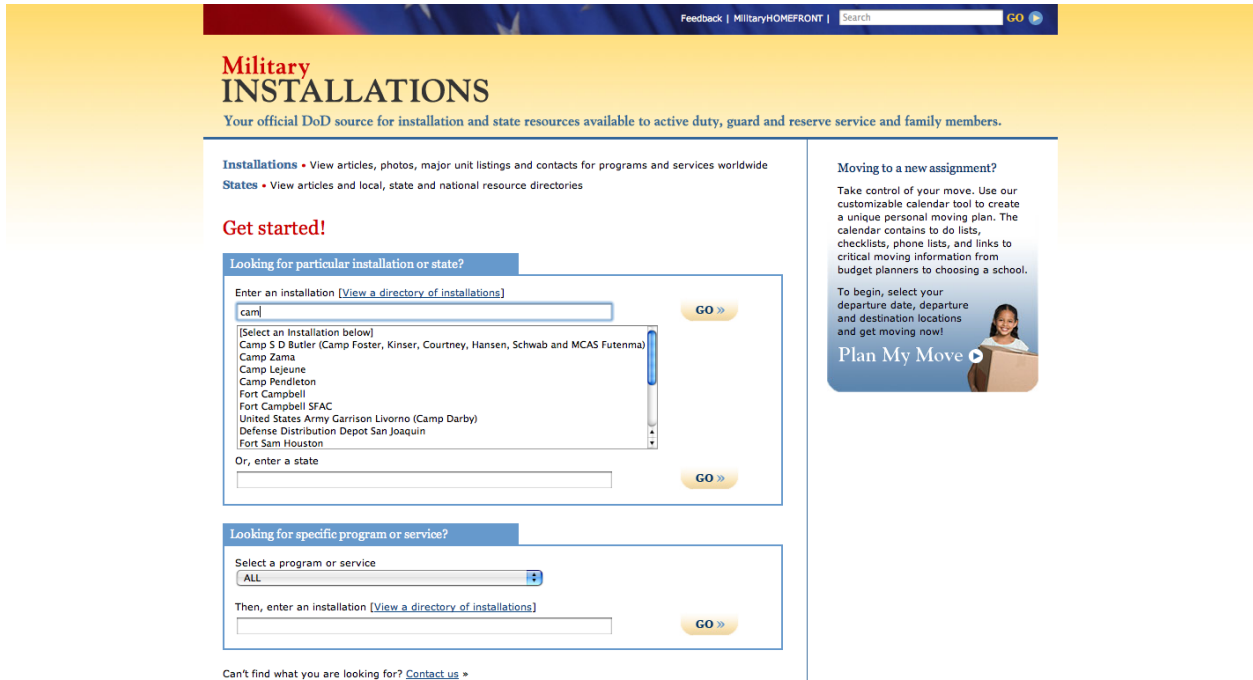
Let's get started by selecting an installation.

Are you moving to a new assignment? Click the button in the right hand column to visit *Plan My Move* where you can use a customizable calendar tool to create a unique personal moving plan.

Select an installation

Begin by typing the first letters of the installation name into the box. That will automatically bring up a list of installations starting with those letters. For this example, we'll type in the letters 'cam' to locate Fort Campbell.



Not sure how to spell the installation name? Simply click the 'View a directory of installations' link to access a listing of all installations, both in the U.S. and abroad, categorized by branch of service.

Now that you've located your installation, click 'GO' and let's see what information is available.

Installations, in-depth

The Fast Fact page is a perfect launching point to get to know the installation. First, look to the left column (A) of the website where you'll find the main contact information for the installation including a link to view a map of the area. Under that, you'll find a list of links offering information on everything from childcare to deployment support.

Click the blue tabs (B) across the top of the content to quickly access an in-depth overview of the installation, contacts for all programs and services offered on-base, a photo gallery, and a comprehensive listing of major units. The next tab, called 'Installation Booklet,' will be an invaluable resource whether you are preparing to relocate or just looking for a quick reference to keep by your phone. You can even customize it to meet the needs of you and your family! The final tab takes you to Military OneSource where you'll find helpful resources for your life outside the gate.

The column on the right (C) also offers loads of information, such as local weather, quick access to your relocation manager, and an extensive list of additional resources. Just click the '+' symbol next to a topic to view helpful links to official resources. You can also access *Plan My Move*, a customizable calendar tool, from this column.

Select a state

Overview

The Joint Family Support Assistance Program (JFSAP) augments existing family programs to provide a continuum of support and services based on member and family strengths and needs and available resources. Our primary focus of support is the military members and families who are geographically dispersed from a military installation.

The Maine JFSAP team consists of a Military OneSource (MOS) Consultant and a Military Family Life Consultant (MFLC).

Maine MOS JFSAP Consultant

The Maine MOS JFSAP Consultant is able to provide outreach and education to families on the military and community support services available; coordinate financial, psychological health, and other support services; connect military families with one another; and serve as an advocate for family needs. The MOS Consultant can be reached by calling 207-232-8710.

Maine JFSAP Military Family Life Consultant

The Maine JFSAP Military Family Life Consultant (MFLC), 207-505-0182, provides non-medical, short-term, solution-focused counseling services to individuals, couples, families, and groups. The MFLC is also available to facilitate educational groups addressing life skills and military lifestyle topics.

Maine's JFSAP Team

Maine's JFSAP Team is organized under the Director of the State Family Program at the Joint Force Headquarters at Camp Keyes in Augusta, Maine. Additional support to military service members and families is provided by the State Family Program under the following programs and personnel:

- **Child and Youth Services** -- This program promotes healthy families through youth events, camps and great national and local programs that encourage and strengthen military families. The Child and Youth Services Specialist can be reached at 207-626-4384.
- **Family Assistance Centers (FAC)** -- Established in 4 geographical areas (Augusta, Portland Caribou and Bangor) designed to give families a place to get information and assistance. FAC support is available 24/7/365 at 1-888-365-9287.
- **Yellow Ribbon Program** -- Assists battalion down to small specialty groups during their deployment cycle by organizing the 30, 60, 90 and 120 day events. Supports pre-deployment briefings, organizing Family Readiness Weekends during deployment, Marriage Enrichment Weekends and education briefings for schools associated with children of deployed service members. The Yellow Ribbon Program can be reached at 207-430-2136.
- **Operation Military Kids (OMK)** -- Supports military youth by raising community awareness to the stresses facing military youth and their families; by creating networks and linking resources of community organizations for families; by providing youth focused programs and camps experiences; by giving out Hero Packs to thank our military youth, and a computer lab for technological support. In addition to the programs and services provided by the State Family Program Office and the JFSAP Team, the Maine Air National Guard provides a variety of support services and programs through the Airman & Family Services Office (AFSO) located at the Bangor Air Guard base. The AFSO is tasked with providing support for Maine airmen and their families at all three Maine ANG duty stations (Bangor, Augusta, and South Portland). The AFSO staff will assist all service members and family members who contact them. The AFSO is responsible for providing: deployment support (pre, during and post), information & referral services, educational programs, volunteer opportunities and family programs. The AFSO staff can be contacted Monday - Friday, and drill weekends, from 7:30-4:00 at 207-990-7494. The 24 hour hotline is 888-625-7200.

States, in-depth

For state information, the Overview page is a perfect launching point. First, look to the left column (A) of the website where you'll find the Joint Forces HQ contact information for the state including email and a web address.

Click the blue tabs (B) across the top of the content to quickly access a state specific resource directory, and also a comprehensive list of installations in the state. You'll find it handy that the list of state installations link over to the Fast Facts. So much information at your finger tips!

Similar to the installation pages, the column on the right (C) offers direct access to Military OneSource as well as an extensive list of additional resources. Just click the '+' symbol next to a topic to view relevant links.

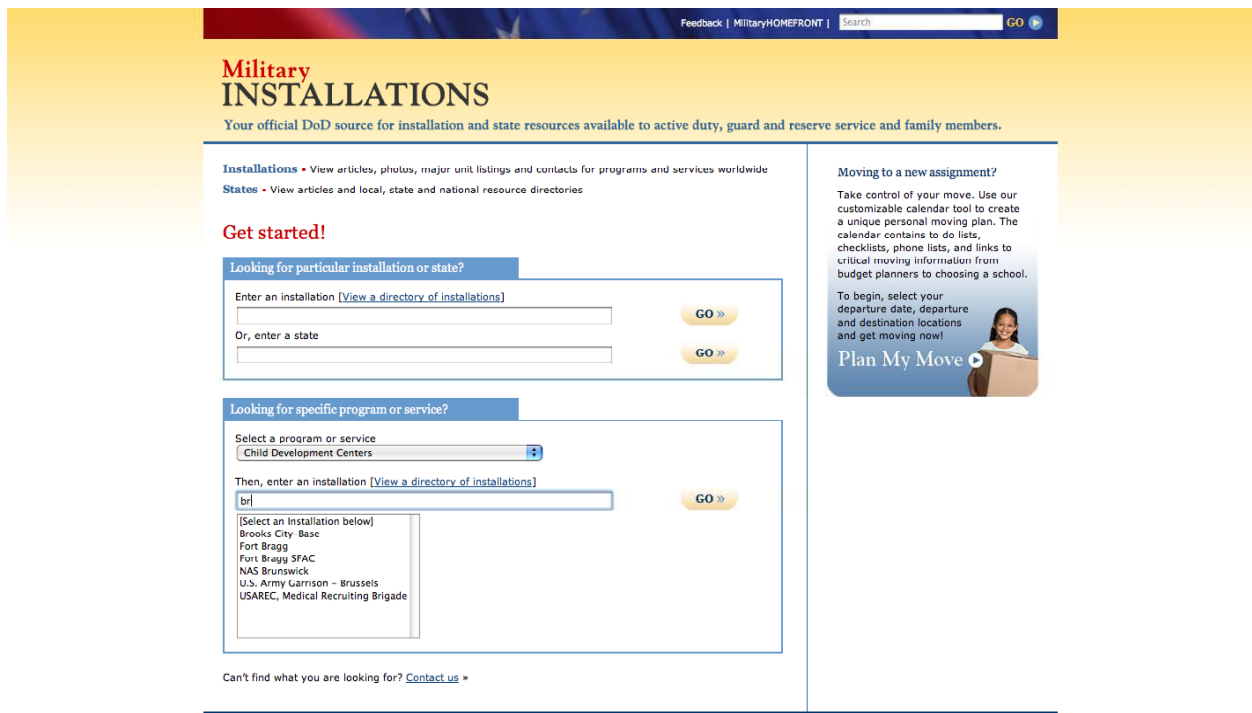

Programs and Services

Return to the entry page by clicking the link in the upper left area of the page. Select a program or service from the drop down menu. Then, start typing in the name of your installation. For this example we'll search for Child Development Centers on Fort Bragg. After you've made both selections, click 'GO.'

The results page presents full contact information for all Child Development Centers on Fort Bragg, including the hours of operation. Click the 'Download' link above the contact to store the information on your computer. You can even click the 'Installation Contacts' tab to view and download a comprehensive contact list of ALL programs and services on an installation.
