Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2009-1055-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA request 2009-1055-F contains a memorandum from Secretary of Defense Aspin to President Clinton regarding the selection of a new Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff and dated from the summer of 1993. This memorandum discusses the biographies of General John Shalikashvili, who was appointed Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff by President Clinton, effective October 25, 1993, and General Joseph Hoar, a publically acknowledged finalist for the post in August of 1993.

The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject Files contains the relevant folder.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in the collection area titled Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files. WHORM Subject files are processed at the document level.

The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination. A complete listing of the categories and detailed descriptions is provided in our research room.
