Provenance

Official records of William Jefferson Clinton's presidency are housed at the Clinton Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2006-0371-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA request 2006-0371-F contains materials from the Counsel's Office concerning the October 20, 2000 presidential pardon of Cheryl Little.

The White House Staff and Office Files of Meredith Cabe contain correspondence between the Counsel's Office and President Clinton. The files include an October 5, 2000 memorandum to the President recommending the pardon of Cheryl Little. Also included are copies of the President's Executive Grant of Clemency.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area—Clinton Presidential Records: White House Staff and Office Files. As policy Staff and Office Files are processed

at the folder level. That is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing.
