Official records of William Jefferson Clinton's presidency are housed at the Clinton Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Scope and Content

The materials in 2006-0515-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA request 2006-0515-F contains records relating to correspondence between Hillary Clinton and Melvin Laird.

The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Alpha Files contained no responsive records.

The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject File contains material from one category. The material relates to correspondence inviting Mrs. Clinton to attend and give the address at the 1995 Youth Leadership Day.

The White House Staff and Office Files contained no responsive records.

The NSC Records Management System contained no responsive records.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area – Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files. WHORM Subject files are processed at the document level.

The WHORM Subject File was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination. A complete listing of the categories with detailed descriptions is provided in our research room.
