FOIA request 2008-0927-F contains material regarding correspondence between President Bill Clinton and singer Raymond Myles. Myles was a New Orleans-based gospel singer.

The White House Office of Records Managagement (WHORM) Subject file contain one repsonsive document, a letter from President Clinton to Myles. This letter thanks Myles for performing at President Clinton's 50<sup>th</sup> birthday party.

### System of Arrangement
