#### **Extent**

Approximately 20 photographs, in color film processed from 35mm negatives.

#### **Access**

#### **Scope and Content**

FOIA case 2009-0530-F contains responsive photos from the White House Photograph Office.

President Clinton and Hillary Rodham Clinton present Peggy Charren a Presidential Medal of Freedom on the State Floor of the White House. The ceremony took place on September 29, 1995. Peggy Charren founded Action for Children's Television (ACT) in 1968 in an effort to improve the quality of children's television programming. In 1989, the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences awarded her its Trustees' Award. Her work with ACT culminated in the passage of the Children's Television Act of 1990, and she received a Peabody Award in 1991.

**System of Arrangement**
