RE: Notice of Termination of Voting System

Pursuant to Section 2.10.7 of the U.S. Election Assistance Commission's (EAC) *Voting System Test Laboratory Program Manual* (Lab Manual), you are hereby notified that the EAC is terminating the application for Unity 4.0.

Section 2.10.7.1 of the Lab Manual states:

Voting system testing shall be considered terminated when the testing process is permanently ended or otherwise halted without a specific plan to recommence within 180 days of the last test performed.
