- Headstart to German
 - Basic introduction to German language, customs, and culture
 - 30 Hours with a field trip
 - Advanced language classes

 - 60 Hours of instruction

Counseling Services

- Education counselors are available to help you set and reach your education goals and take full advantage of your education benefits.
- Education counselors can help you with:

Tuition Assistance (TA)

- \$4500 per FY, \$250/semester hour cap
- TA can pay towards first certificate, associate, bachelor's, and master's degree
- Contact your education counselor to establish a GoArmyEd account
- Request TA online **prior** to each class through **GoArmyEd.com**
- Maintain an Army GPA of 2.0 or higher
- TA does not cover books and some fees
- Military withdrawals
- Class results that can result in recoupment: personal withdrawals, failing grades, incomplete grades over 120 days
- Officers incur a 2 year service obligation with use of TA

- University of Maryland University College (UMUC)
 - Certificates
 - Associate and Bachelors Degrees in several disciplines with classes available in the classroom and on line.

- University of Oklahoma and University of Phoenix
 - Masters Degrees only
- Online programs at accredited colleges

Other ways to earn college credit...

- Conversion of military schools to college credit:
 - AARTS transcripts are available free of charge
 - Recommends college credit for some military training experience
 - Colleges review and may grant credit
 - Once on college transcript may be used towards civilian education promotion points
