- Purpose: To identify and prioritize issues impacting Soldier, Family, and civilian standards of living; to assist Army Leadership establish priorities for the transforming Army.



Child Abuse/Domestic Violence

- Child Abuse
- Neglect –failure to provide basic necessities
- Physical -minor or major physical and internal injuries
- Emotional- berating, disparaging or other abusive behavior
- Sexual –rape, exploitation, incest, molestation
- Out of home –school, daycare, or any DOD settings

Domestic Violence

- Physical- violence used to intimidate, control, or force the spouse/partner to do something against his/her will
- Emotional- a pattern of acts or omissions, such as violent acts that may cause no observable injury, that adversely affect the psychological wellbeing of the spouse/partner
- Sexual- forces sexual act upon a partner- marital rape
