OVERSEAS TOUR LENGTHS

36 MONTH TOUR

- ☐ Soldiers with command sponsored family members
- ☐ Career Soldiers (those that have reenlisted at least once) with no family members





OVERSEAS TOUR LENGTHS JOINT DOMICILE ASSIGNMENTS

- □ 36 months (extension is authorized to match DEROS if outside the reenlistment window)
- ☐ If couple marries while overseas, each serves the original tour length of the last Soldier to arrive in country (extension is authorized to match DEROS if outside the reenlistment window)





OVERSEAS TOUR LENGTHS 24 MONTHS / UNACCOMPANIED TOUR

- ☐ Single, initial term Soldiers
- □ Soldiers with family members who serve an unaccompanied tour
- □ Divorced or legally separated Soldiers who pay child support





SERVICE REMAINING REQUIREMENT TO PCS TO CONUS

- □ 13 months of service remaining from tour completion to ETS is required to PCS to CONUS
- ☐ Extension must be accomplished prior to entering the reenlistment window (24 months prior to ETS)
- ☐ You will be assigned IAW the needs of the army





- □ Regular Army
- Current Station Stabilization
- ☐ Army Training (ASI, SQI or MOS)
- Overseas Assignment
- ☐ CONUS Station of choice
- NOTE: OPTIONS MAY VARY FOR EVERY SOLDIER.





POST 911 GI BILL

- □ Cannot have an adverse action flag at the time of the approval.
- Must have at least 6 years of service in the Armed Forces
- ☐ Agree to serve 4 additional years or...
- □ Have at least 10 years of service and cannot commit to 4 additional years due to RCP or MRD and commit to serve the maximum amount of time allowed by the RCP or MRD.





POST 911 GI BILL

- Retirement eligible or become retirement eligible during the period from 1 Aug 2009 through 1 Aug 2013 and agree to serve the additional period, if any, specified below.
 - Retirement eligible on or before 1 Aug 2009, no additional service is required.
 - Soldiers with an approved retirement date on or after 1 Sep 2009, but on or before 2 Aug 2010, one year of additional service is required.
