## 354th Fighter Wing Home of the Iceman Team

Eielson Air Force Base is home to the 354th Fighter Wing. The base, 26 miles southeast of Fairbanks, was established in 1944.



With its 14,500-foot runway, Eielson is home to the 355th Fighter Squadron, which flies the A-10, and the 18th Fighter Squadron, which

flies the F-16. The Alaska Air National Guard's 168th Air Refueling Wing, based at Eielson, flies the KC-135 refueler aircraft.



Alaska is home to the world's largest fully instrumented training ranges—covering 62,000 square miles, which is roughly the size of Kansas. These ranges provide unmatched training for U.S. and allied forces.

Eielson's strategic location means the Air Force can deploy faster from Eielson to Europe and Asia than units in the Lower 48. The base's location also makes it the nucleus of an "air bridge" to the Pacific should wartime or other operational taskings arise.
