Picerne scholarship, grant applications available now: Applications for the 2013 Our Future Scholarship and 2013 Educational Grant are now available at www.ourfamilyfoundation.org. The Foundation is committed to supporting military Families in the pursuit of higher education and has awarded more than \$3.5 million since 2006. **Applications for the Our Future Scholarship must be submitted by February 14, 2013**, and will be awarded to high school seniors with plans of attending a four-year university or college in the amount of up to \$50,000 each. The foundation

will select 10 children of active-duty service members at Fort Riley, Fort Meade, Md.; Fort Bragg, N.C.; Fort Polk, La.; Fort Rucker, Ala.; Fort Sill, Okla.; and Aberdeen Proving Ground, Md., to receive the scholarships based on merit and need. Recipients of a scholarship will be notified by April 8, 2013. "We are honored to help military Families reach their educational goals, and we hope these scholarships help the children and spouses of active duty service members to reach higher," said Maria Montalvo, executive director. **Applications for 2013 educational grants must be submitted by May 9, 2013.** Grants are given in amounts up to \$5,000 for the spouse of an active-duty service member at the installations listed above. Applicants may be in any stage of the educational process. Recipients of a grant will be notified by July 12, 2013. Applications and all necessary paperwork for both the Our Future Scholarship and Educational Grant must be submitted by the due date in order to be considered. 


