



WMD Standardized Awareness Training AWR-160 Course Test-Out Option

Course Description:

The WMD Standardized Awareness Training Course provides emergency responders with awareness-level instruction on recognition, avoidance, isolation, and notification techniques in a WMD environment. The course covers prevention and deterrence of chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear, and explosive hazards. Counter Terrorism Operations Support (CTOS) provides a test-out option for the instructor led course developed by the National Domestic Preparedness Consortium.

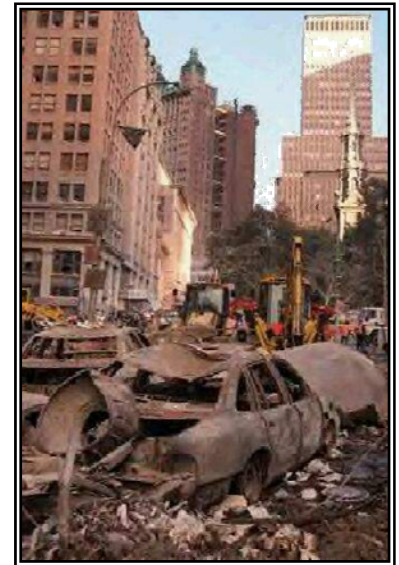
