UPDATE CREWS CONTINUE TO FIGHT WILDFIRE AT THE NEVADA NATIONAL SECURITY SITE

North Las Vegas – Firefighters are reporting significant progress in containing the wildfires at the Nevada National Security Site (NNSS), which is located 65 miles northwest of Las Vegas, NV:

NEW INFORMATION

- The *Timber Fire*, located in a remote area in the western portion of the site, is now 25 percent contained.
- The *Weston Fire*, which had been burning several miles to the south of the Timber Fire, is now 100 percent contained
- Neither fire location is near any historic testing areas.
- Approximately 100 responders, a helicopter and four fixed-wing aircraft are currently battling the fire.

PREVIOUS INFORMATION

- All personnel have been accounted for
- No infrastructure has been impacted
- 6,000+ total acres have burned
- NNSS Fire and Rescue are responding with assistance from Bureau of Land Management (BLM)
- Lightning caused

This is what we know to be the most current information at this time. Additional information will be provided as it becomes available.
