Dear Mr. Saffari:

IGT has requested from this office a formal classification opinion on Reel Touch Bingo version 1.4a. To that end, IGT has submitted a complete game description, supporting mathematics, and a working prototype. I have made a preliminary determination that the game, if played as described, is Class II.

The General Counsel will issue a final opinion after we have completed our review. In order to do so, we require a report from an independent testing laboratory verifying the game's characteristics and mathematics.

In addition, after the machines are placed in the field, we would like IGT to provide empirical data, from a period of 3 weeks, showing as a percentage of players' wagers the amounts paid out as prizes for achieving the game-winning pattern. It would be most helpful if this data could be broken down by individual machine. In any event, IGT need not provide this data before the final opinion is issued.

I greatly appreciate the cooperation you and your staff have given us throughout our review, and I look forward to working with you further. Please feel free to call if you have any questions or concerns.
