- 3. Most of your base in-processing will be accomplished during Right Start. You or your sponsor should call the Airman & Family Readiness Center (225-8725) to register. Right Start also includes the driver's course and test to obtain your USFJ Form 4EJ (operator's permit). You must have this permit to operate a vehicle on Yokota AB. Included in this sponsor package is a copy of the study guide for your test.

Please take a few moments to review both the AFRC and AFAS Programs brochures (also located in this folder) for great information on services available to all ID cardholders, as well as information on free childcare during your PCS. A loan locker and loaner furniture are also available upon your arrival; use the information on these documents to help you plan your HHG and Unaccompanied Baggage shipments.
