Dear Ms. Worley:

This is in response to your letter of May 15, 2008, requesting that the National Indian Gaming Commission (NIGC) review two gaming device agreements (Agreements) between Aristocrat Technologies Incorporated and Bay Mills Resort & Casino.

The purpose of our review is to determine whether either of the Agreements is a management contract or agreement collateral to a management contract and, therefore, subject to the review and approval of the NIGC Chairman under the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act. After careful review, it is my opinion that neither Agreement is a management contract. As such, neither requires the NIGC Chairman's approval.
