Re: Proposed Lease Agreement between Sodak Gaming and the Western Delaware Tribe

Dear Mr. Green:

By correspondence dated January 10, 2005, Laine Coolidge, General Manager of the Gold River Casino, advised the Office of General Counsel of the NIGC that you have been retained to represent the Western Delaware Tribe regarding the above-referenced matter.

By letter dated November 3, 2004^1 , we informed the Tribe of our concern that the proposed agreement between them and Sodak Gaming evidences a proprietary interest by Sodak in the Tribe's gaming activity. Moreover, we conveyed that such a proprietary interest would be contrary to IGRA, NIGC regulations, and the Western Delaware Tribe's gaming ordinance. See 25 U.S.C. § 2710 (b)(2)(A); 25 C.F.R. § 522.4(b)(1); Gaming Ordinance of the Delaware Tribe of Western Oklahoma (July 14, 1995) § 3.1.

In light of this concern, in such letter, we requested that the parties provide us with a written justification for the fee obtained by Sodak pursuant to this agreement. Please advise us when such written justification will be forthcoming from the Tribe. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to contact me at (202) 632-7003.
