In accordance with MDA Directive 4700.01, Environmental Management Program, dated May 27, 2010, MDA is committed to continual improvement of its Environmental Management Program. The Agency will strive to integrate environmental requirements into systems engineering processes and long-term planning to minimize the lifecycle environmental impacts of the Ballistic Missile Defense System (BMDS).

MDA will accomplish its environmental stewardship by:

- Complying with statutory and regulatory environmental requirements.
- Pursuing pollution prevention as the preferred means of meeting existing or emerging environmental requirements.
- Establishing and updating environmental objectives and targets.
- Using “green” procurement and technologies where practical to efficiently conserve resources over the BMDS lifecycle.
- Conserving and sustaining cultural and natural resources at host test ranges, installations, and facilities.
- Providing MDA personnel and contractors environmental awareness training and recognizing and rewarding outstanding environmental stewardship.
