TALKING PAPER - SECRETARY ROGERS

At the President's personal request, Director Hoover has come up with some recommendations regarding increasing the number of FBI agents based abroad as legal attaches to U.S. embassies.

Because of the hijacking problem and the increasing amount of international activity related to domestic violence, the President feels very strongly that this step must be done. He does not have confidence in the CIA abroad to deal with this situation and wants it handled through the FBI.

This should not be put through the bureaucracy - it should just be done quietly and quickly by you working directly with Director Hoover.
